PRELIMINARY STATEMENTS

- A. While the official name of this public utility is "CC Communications Telephone" it is hereinafter referred to in the tariff pages as "CC Communications" or "company". Whenever the word "company" appears in these tariffs with reference to CC Communications, it shall have the same weight, intent and meaning as if the full legal name of the system were used in all such instances.
- B. The Tariffs, containing Rates, Rules and Regulations, have been approved by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Churchill and are effective as of the dates indicated thereon.
- C. A complete file of all of the company's tariffs is maintained in the local office of the company in Fallon, Nevada, and they are available for public inspection, during regular business hours on regular business days.
- D. The tariffs on Definitions and on Rules and Regulations and the tariffs covering the services govern the procedures to be followed by the Company in rendering the services. All of said tariffs also explain phrases and terms used.
- E. The digital type of central office equipment is in use in the company's system.
- F. The exchange boundaries are undefined, however, the boundaries of Churchill County are the serving area of CC Communications.
- G. CC Communications is the sole claimant of any and all numbering or circuit identification and reserves the right to assign all such designations at their discretion.
- H. CC Communications will supply and maintain the communications equipment listed in these tariffs only as long as it is reasonably obtainable and maintainable. The determination of obsolescence is at the telephone system's determination.
